Bacon, chicken salad, egg salad, ham, hummus, salami, tuna salad, or turkey

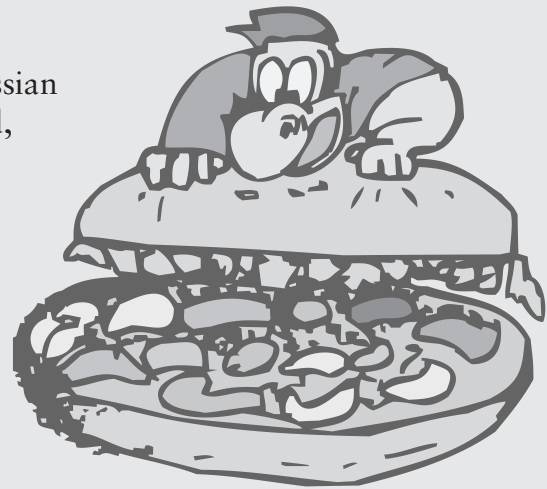
STEP 3: Choose two decorations
